ISSUE OF ADMIT CARDS & CHANGE OF CENTRES FOR CONDUCT OF WRITTEN EXAM FOR COOK & VEHICLE MECHANIC POSTS AGAINST (ADVERTISEMENT No. 01/ 2019 ON 01st NOVEMBER 2020

1. All candidates are informed that written exam for the posts of **COOK** and **VEHICLE MECHANIC** posts against Advertisement No. 01/2019 will be conducted on **01 NOVEMBER 2020 at 1200 Hrs to 1500 Hrs** (12 PM to 3 PM)(For all caste categories).
2. In view of the unprecedented COVID situation the written test is being conducted first and Merit will be drawn on the basis of the marks of the written exam to call candidates for further recruitment procedure as per vacancies in the respective caste categories for the particular post.
3. The syllabus for the exam is same as per the details given in the original advertisement for the post.
4. All candidates are informed that the admit cards have been sent by registered post at the postal address of the candidates mentioned in the application form, candidates must be in touch with the local postal authorities and the details of the centre allotted to candidate has been published in BRO Website also.
5. It has been tried to allot examination centre near the candidates place of residence, however **in case any candidate wants change of examination centre** he should apply to **GRAF Centre before 25 Oct 2020** and send application at **020-27171231** (FAX) or through E-mail : **bro-cen@nic.in** and should positively intimate his mobile and E-mail address. **No application for change of examination centre will be accepted after 25 Oct 2020.**
6. **IMPORTANT NOTICE.**
 - (a) It is brought out that candidates are forwarding applications **without genuine reasons** and are also **not mentioning their Roll/ Control Numbers**, thereby those applications cannot be considered.
 - (b) In case Candidate does not get his admit card by 25 October 2020 then he should inform GRAF Centre at **020-27171231** (FAX) or through E-mail : **bro-cen@nic.in** and can report to allotted centre with print out of the BRO Website list of centre where candidates name is figuring along with valid identity proof.
7. In view of the COVID situation all candidates will be required to follow COVID Protocol as laid down by the Government of India. It is mandatory for all candidates to follow under mentioned points on the day of the exam:-
 - (a) Wear Face Mask (No entry without Face Mask).
 - (b) Wear Hand Gloves (No entry without Hand Gloves).
 - (c) Can carry small hand sanitizer (50 ml).
 - (d) Carry Admit Card, Adhar Card etc.
 - (e) Maintain Social Distancing when entering the examination Hall.
