Online bids are invited on single stage two bid system for : **RISK AND COST CONTRACT FOR COMPLETION OF INCOMPLETE WORK (SUPERSTRUCTURE AND RELATED WORKS) OF DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF 60 MTR SINGLE SPAN MAJOR PERMANENT BRIDGE WITH PSC BOX GIRDER TYPE SUPERSTRUCTURE ON OPEN FOUNDATION OVER KISHAN GANGA RIVER (CHAK NALLAH BRIDGE) AT KM 7.525 ON DAWAR-NIRU-BARUAB-CHAKWALI-KAOBALGALI ROAD UNDER PROJECT BEACON IN J&K STATE (NOW UT)**

3. Bids shall be submitted online only on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app>. Manual bids shall not be accepted. Tenderer/Contractors are advised to follow the instructions provided in the "Instruction to the Contractors/Tenderer for the e-submission of the bids online through the Defence Procurement Portal for e-Procurement on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app>" before proceeding ahead.

4. The work is estimated to cost Rs 296.09 Lakh (Rupees Two Crore Ninety Six Lakh Nine Thousand only) approximately or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app>. This estimate, however, is not a guarantee and is merely given as a rough guide and if works cost more or less, the tenderer shall have no claim on that account of what so ever nature.

5. The tender shall be based on drawing, specifications, General Conditions of Contracts IAFW-2249 Z and item rate contract form based on IAFW 2249 Z with schedule 'A' (list of works) to be priced by the tenderer.

6. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor or contractors having business relationship. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

7. The work is to be completed within 25 Months from the date of placing of Work Order or as subsequently amended in tender documents or uploaded on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> on accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender from the date of handing over the site, which will be generally within one month from the date of issue of acceptance letter.

8. The Chief Engineer Project Beacon, C/O 56 APO will be the Accepting Officer, here in after, referred to as such for the purpose of this contract.

9. Intending tenderers are advised to visit again on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> 03 (three) days prior to date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / addendum/ amendment.

10. **Earnest Money:-** Earnest money is not required to be attached with tender by the valid enlisted contractor with BRO who have submitted standing security deposit and MSME registered firm AS PER Rule 170 (i) of GFR 2017 but it is required from other contractors and to be attached (Scanned copy) with Technical Bid Rs 3,71,088.00 (Rupees Three Lakh Seventy One Thousand Eighty Eight only) in the shape of call Receipt/Term Deposit Receipt/Special Term Deposit Receipt in favour of Chief Engineer Project Beacon, C/O 56 APO obtained from any Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank and having maturity/validity period 90 days more than validity period of his offer.

11. **Successful Bidder (L-1) shall deliver to Accepting Officer a Performance Security for an amount of 3% of contract sum in the shape of Bank Guarantee or FDR within 28 days of issue of LoA.**


12. Copies of drawing (if applicable) and other documents pertaining to the work (signed for the purpose of identification by the Accepting Officer or his accredited representative) and sample of materials and stores to be supplied by the contractor will be opened for inspection at the following locations :-

14. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of all relevant documents, samples, site etc whether he had inspected them or not.

15. Any qualification documents/ tender which stipulates any alternative to any of the conditions laid down or which proposes any other conditions of any description whatsoever is liable to be rejected.

16. The Accepting Officer reserves his right to accept a tender submitted by a Public Undertaking, giving a purchase preference over other tender(s) which may be lower, as are admissible under the Govt policy. No claim for any compensation or otherwise shall be admissible from such tenderers whose tenders may be rejected on account of the said policy.

17. The submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he had read this notice and conditions of contract and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of the conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc will be issued to him, local conditions and other factors bearing on the execution of the work.

18. The Pre-Contract Integrity Pact (applicable for tender with estimated cost of Rs 5 Crore and above for all works contracts and in tender for procurement of services, stores, equipments & plants with estimated cost of Rs 1 Crore and above) has been signed by Accepting Officer or by the Officer specifically designated by him and scanned copy uploaded as part of NIT along with tender documents. Scanned copy of Integrity Pact duly signed on each pages by the bidder(s) shall be uploaded as part of technical bid (Cover-I) and original Integrity Pact duly signed on each pages shall be forwarded by post along tender documents.


19. The scanned copy of original instruments in respect of earnest money, Integrity Pact duly signed on each page by the bidder(s), and under taking regarding acceptance of tender conditions, Enlistment letter if firm is enlisted in BRO, EPFO, Registration letter, GST Registration and any other documents must be uploaded along with the technical bid. The Hard copies of all the documents should reach the tender Inviting Authority in the sealed within 05 days of bid submission end date.

20. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from the BRO website shall not temper/modify the tender form in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tempered/modify in any manner, tender will be summarily rejected and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with BRO.

21. The accepting officer does not bind himself to accept the lowest or any tender or to give any reason for doing so.

22. In case of applications/bids (enlisted contractors/ as well as un-enlisted contractors) where scanned copies of requisite Earnest Money (as applicable) were uploaded, but the same are not received in physical form within stipulated time, such bids not qualify for opening of finance bid


23. In case of rejection of technical bid, contractor may appeal to Next higher Engineer Authority i.e HQ ADGBR(NW), Chandigarh on email bro-adgnw@nic.in)/CE (P) Beacon on email bro-bcn@nic.in with copy to the Accepting Officer i.e., CE/TF Commander, 32 BRTF on email bro.32brtf@gmail.com against rejection within 05 days from the date of publishing of result of Technical bid qualification on the DPP Portal whose decision shall be final and binding. If the appeal is not made within this period, the bidder shall forfeit his right of appeal against rejection of his Technical bid. Any appeal received after 05 days of such publication of result shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

 The Next Higher Authority shall preferably try to resolve the issue within 10 days of such representation. However, contractor/ bidder shall not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever on account of rejection of technical bid

In the event of lowest tenderer revoking his offer or revising his rates upward (which will be treated as revocation of offer), after opening of tenders, the earnest money deposited by him shall be forfeited. In case of BRO enlisted contractors, the amount equal to the earnest money stipulated in the Notice of tender, shall be notified to the tenderer for depositing the amount through MRO, failing which the amount shall be recovered from payment due to such contractor or shall be adjusted from the Standing Security Deposit. In addition, such tenderer and his related firm shall not be allowed to participate in the tendering in second call or subsequent calls.
26. Important-Above particulars may change due to administrative or any other reason and shall be available on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app>. Therefore bidders/contractors are requested to visit on DPP site <https://defproc.gov.in/nicgep/app> frequently and at least once again 03 (three) days prior to bid submission date as per critical date sheet for any change in the above particulars.
